Order under Section 3(1)(a) of the Quarantine Act 2020: Prohibition of Aircraft and Ships into Mauritius

WHEREAS section 3(l)(a) of the Quarantine Act 2020 provides that during a quarantine period, the Prime Minister may, by Order published in the Gazette, prohibit the entry of aircraft and ships into Mauritius.

- 2. NOW THEREFORE, I do hereby prohibit, by virtue of <u>section 3(1)(a)</u> of the Quarantine Act 2020, the entry of aircraft and ships into Mauritius until 15 January 2021, except for those aircraft and ships as I may approve.
- 3. General Notice No. 1552 of 2020 is hereby revoked.
