General Notice No. 1545 of 2020

NOTICE UNDER SECTION 4(1) OF THE QUARANTINE ACT 2020

WHEREAS section 4(1) of the Quarantine Act 2020 provides that where the Minister considers that it is necessary and expedient to prevent the introduction and spread in Mauritius of a communicable disease, he shall, by notice published in the Gazette, declare that –

- (a) there is or is likely to be an epidemic of the disease; and
- (b) a quarantine period shall be in force in Mauritius, or part thereof, as from such date as may be specified in the notice.

2. WHEREAS I was satisfied that it was necessary and expedient to prevent the introduction and spread of COVID-19 in Mauritius, I ordered, by virtue of General Notice No. 1218 of 2020 –

- (a) that there was still an epidemic of COVID-19; and
- (b) the extension of the quarantine period in Mauritius from 31 August 2020 to 31 October 2020.

3. NOW, THEREFORE, in view of the fact that I am still satisfied that it is necessary and expedient to prevent the introduction and spread of COVID-19 in Mauritius, I do hereby –

- (a) declare that there is still an epidemic of COVID-19; and
- (b) extend the quarantine period in Mauritius from 31 October 2020 to 30 November 2020.
